Basic Navigation

Using your monitoring software, YourSix will provide a URL to access the Inspect application. Upon access to the application, you will see a screen similar to the below. The left side of the screen will be the playback of footage and the right side will be the live footage from that same device.



Main Screen Overview

1. Playback Footage	This footage will start playing immediately upon the screen loading. The footage will start from 4 seconds before the alarm was triggered.
2. Playback Timeline	This timeline will allow you to navigate forward and backwards to view saved footage. The loaded footage upon initial access will be 4 seconds prior to the alarm.
3. Live Footage	This video will be the live footage of the device which triggered the alarm.
4. Site Name	Site that the player/device is located.
5. Context Bar	Expand this to add additional players to the live view.



Playback Footage

Upon loading of the page, the playback footage will automatically start playing footage from 4 seconds prior to the alarm. Users can use the timeline along the bottom of the screen to navigate forward or backwards in time to view footage. The bottom of the timeline will show where recorded footage is available. This depends on recording rules setup by the integrator.

- Blue represents Cloud stored footage
- Green represents SD stored footage on the device
- Purple represents footage stored to a local NAS

Users simply click on the timeline in order to view footage from that point. Users can also zoom in and out on the timeline using the icons on the left side of the timeline.

Playback Source

Hovering over the Playback Footage player will bring up a menu in the upper right corner of that player which will allow you to select the source of the playback footage and an option to put the player into full screen.

The selectable option (Cloud, SD car, NAS) for the source will only show if footage at that time is available for the source. Use the bottom of the timeline for indicators of which sources have footage at certain times. This will be indicated by the blue, green, and purple lines along the bottom of the screen.





Live Footage

Hovering over the Live Footage player will bring up a menu in the upper right corner of that player which will show available actions. The icons that appear will be limited to the capabilities of that player/device.



Action Icons

	Remove player from view	This icon will remove the player from the canvas.
1280x720 ¥	Resolution	Selecting the drop down will allow you to select the resolution of the player.
÷	PTZ presets	Selecting this icon will give you a drop down to select from a list of preset PTZ positions.
¥	Microphone control	This icon will allow you to mute or unmute the player for devices equipped with a microphone.
Ż	Talkdown control	This icon will allow you to perform a talkdown.
8	Full screen video	Selecting this icon will take you to full screen mode.
I/O	Input-Output	This icon will allow you to set an I/O board trigger to on, off, or pulse.



Add Live Players

While viewing a live player on the right portion of the screen, you can add additional players to view live.



□ Expand the Context Bar along the right side of the screen by selecting the expand icon (<<)

□ From the list of players, select ADD to add it to the live footage canvas

To remove the player, simply select **REMOVE**

□ To collapse the Context Bar select **Hide Menu** at the bottom of the screen
